



Globi goes searching for tracks in the woods: What animals live here? What is the soft forest floor made of? How old do trees grow? These and further questions are discussed in "Globi's Forest Lab". On this interpretative nature trail, children from seven to twelve years learn about the ecosystem of the forest with a student guide, while playfully deep diving into the world of natural sciences. At Waldlabor Zurich, close by to ETH Campus Hönggerberg, they spend an instructive morning or afternoon by performing fascinating experiments. They learn about the circle of water, find out how trees grow tall and what layers a forest consists of.

"Globi's Forest Lab" has evolved through a cooperation with Waldlabor Zurich.

The outdoor nature trail is suitable for school classes with children aged 7 to 12.
